Corporate Structure

University College of Yayasan Pahang, formerly known as Kolej Yayasan Pahang (Taman Gelora) is capable in meeting, introducing and executing significant courses listed by the country in efforts to producing the catalyst for human capital. Since 1992, the institution that belongs to KYP Education Sdn. Bhd. has offered the short courses like ACCA, LCCI, ABE and IAW. Apart from UCYP, KYP Education Sdn. Bhd. also comprises of KYP (Indera Mahkota) and KYP Advanced Skills.

In 1994, UCYP commenced its international and local collaborations. At that time, UCYP offered local programmes in collaboration with University Teknologi Malaysia (UTM) and Universiti Teknologi Mara (UiTM).

In 1998, KYP Advanced Skills (KYP-AS) added National Vocational Training Council (MLVK) programme by Ministry of Human Resource that offered courses like Hotel Industries Apprenticeship Scheme (HIAS), Computer System, Fashion, Bakery, Automotive and Plantations.

With the wide and vast exposure as well as lengthy experiences gained by UCYP, in 2001, the college (at that time) then developed home-grown programmes and international academic collaboration with Napier University, Heriot Watt University and Yarmouk University.

The new phase of UCYP began in 2008 by the transformation of the institution as an International College. In the period of change, the management planned to have a new campus and the facility development started in Tanjung Lumpur in 2012.

In year 2015, UCYP initiated a Smart Tahfiz Programme that was offered to religious school leavers. The main aim is to produce a generation of huffaz who are knowledgeable and skillful.

Along with the construction of the new campus and facility development, the college (at that time) has gone through a rebranding process and decided to be known as Kolej Yayasan Pahang in 2016. After two (2) years of the transformation, the college had managed to upgrade its status into a University College in 2018 and now known as UCYP (University College of Yayasan Pahang).

UCYP keeps moving forward as to position itself as a recognized educational institution in the South East Asia Region.





LETTER OF ACCEPTING

Upon meeting the entry requirements and receiving the payment (Applications Fee and EMGS Visa Processing Fee), UCYP will email a scanned copy of the Letter of Acceptance. Then, UCYP will proceed to apply for the Visa Approval Letter on behalf of the student. This process will take approximately 6-8 weeks

* if EMGS reject the application, please take note that processing fee is non-refundable.

VISA APPROVAL LETTER (VAL)

When UCYP International Offic received the required fees i.e. have been credited into KYP EDUCATION's bank account via Telegraphic Transfer or Bank Draft, it will courier the original Letter of Acceptance and the Original Visa Approval Letter to the eligible international student.

PRE ARRIVAL PROCESS

Once UCYP has obtained approval from the Malaysian Immigration, we will send to students the approval letter together with Letter of Offer which will require endorsing your Single Entry Visa.

Please email or fax the airport pick request to the International Office at least 10 days before your departure date. Required information needed:

- Date of Arrival
- · Time of Arrival
- Flight name and number
- Airport name i.e. Kuala Lumpur International Airport (KLIA)

Immigration Clearance

An officer from the UCYP International Office will meet you at the airport's immigration clearance point and assist you in immigration clearance. Please take note that you will not be able to clear immigration without the presence of an officer from the college.

POST ARRIVAL PROCESS

The student must report to the UCYP International Student Office, located at the Taman Gelora Campus.
Students need to submit the passport to the UCYP International Office and will provide students a certified true copy of their passport for safekeeping pending the Student Pass endorsement with the Malaysian

All students must undergo for the Medical Health Report/Check up at the panel clinic within 7 days upon arrival in Malaysia which will be determined by the Education Malaysia Global Services (EMGS). The report will be released within 3-4 days and the students must be in good health. If the students are not in good health and have been advised by the doctor not to register, they have to return to home country immediately.

The registration at the main campus will be arranged by the UCYP International Office after the students have completed the registration and visa process.

After the registration at the main campus, all students need to attend the Induction & Orientation Program.
